#### Meet a Canadian grizzly bear

- Little boys and girls often have a best friend: Their teddy bear is always with them when they are sad and lonely. So bears are a part of our culture but most of us can never see one in real life in Europe.
- However, there are about 75,000 grizzlies left in the USA and Canada. Many companies organize bear watching safaries for nature lovers.



Julius Strauss, the owner of the 'Grizzly Bear Ranch' says: "Some years ago, I worked as a reporter in Kosovo and in different other places in the world. My new job here is not as dangerous as my old one, but it never gets boring. The ranch lies by a beautiful river at the bottom of the Rocky Mountains. Between May and October the bears come down from the mountains to catch fish in the river. Sometimes I can see up to ten bears a day. I spend my days driving around tourists in a jeep to show them these fascinating animals. Bears are not typically dangerous if you follow our rules and are careful. But they live in wilderness and are so strong that they even could kill a lion. I love my bears and I want everyone to know just how beautiful they are."

What makes him angry is that the Canadian <u>law</u> still <u>allows</u> shooting the animals. He hopes that grizzly watching will become more and more interesting to tourists from all over the world. Then Canada's government will perhaps stop bear hunting.

#### 1 School exchange in Ireland

Last year Lisa Schröder, 18, was an exchange student at St. Augustine's College near Dublin. This is what she says about her school year in Ireland where she was for 10 months:

"I was very happy when I first met my host family. John and Audrey Donovan have four children. This was ideal for me, because I also come from a big family and they made me feel at home. Of course, I was a little bit homesick at first, but there was so much to do all the day that I didn't have time to get sad.



In Ireland the school day is long, from 9.00 am to 3.45 pm. There are a few differences to German schools. For example, the classes are much smaller. And students can choose the subjects they take, but everyone has to do Irish, English and maths. I liked it at school, and I didn't have any problems with the English language. Some lessons, like maths, were easier, but others, for example biology, were more difficult in Ireland. Because I was an exchange student, I didn't have to do Irish, but I learned a few sentences just for fun."


